
It has been brought to the notice of this office that Section 20(1) of the Rajasthan Advocates Welfare Fund Act has been amended vide Gazette Notification No. F.4 (8) Vidhi/2/ 2012 dt. 28.05.2012 which is as under :-

“Amendment of Section 20, Rajasthan Act No. 15 of 1987.- In sub-section (1) of section 20 of the principal Act, for the existing expression “rupees ten”, the expression “rupees twenty five” shall be substituted.”

It is, therefore, enjoined upon the presiding officers of all the subordinate courts to make strict compliance of amended Section 20(1) of the Rajasthan Advocates Welfare Fund Act, 1987 and no such Vakalatnama or Memo of Appearance or any other document by which an advocate represents his clients, to a Court of Law, should be accepted unless it is accompanied by a requisite Welfare Fund Stamp of Rs. 25/- as per Section 20 of the Act.


