Sub:- Schedule of election for the post of office bearers of the Rajasthan State Bar Council including members of the various committees and Member representative of the Bar Council of India.

Sir,

In reference to aforesaid letters, I have been directed to inform you that for those state Bar Councils, where the number of elected members is 25 then they may elect the 6 (six) Co- Chairman for 6 different zones to be identified by State Bar Council and their jurisdiction may be divided zone wise. In the light of above, you may elect six Co-Chairman instead of four, as communicated in our earlier letter. Aforesaid letters are modified to that extent accordingly however, other content of the letters shall remain same.

As far as name of various committees are concerned, the **Bar Council of India** has not received any detail from your State Bar Council about the various committees to be elected, as per State Bar Council Rules. Therefore, you are required to conduct the election of the committee(s), as per Rule.
