बार कौंसिल ऑफ इण्डिया, नई दिल्ली ने अपने ईमेल दिनांक 22.04.2017 के द्वारा यह सूचित किया है कि बार कौंसिल ऑफ इण्डिया का एक प्रतिनिधिमण्डल दिनांक 21.04.2017 को माननीय श्री रविशंकर प्रसाद, केन्द्रीय कानून एवं न्याय मंत्री से मिला। माननीय कानून एवं न्याय मंत्री ने प्रतिनिधिमण्डल को यह आश्वासन दिया है कि भारतीय विधि आयोग द्वारा प्रस्तुत सिफारिशों पर कोई कार्यवाही नहीं की जावेगी, जब तक कि उस पर बार कौंसिल ऑफ इण्डिया, राज्य बार कौंसिल एवं देशभर की बार संघों से विस्तारपूर्वक विचार विमर्श/चर्चा नहीं हो जाती है। माननीय केन्द्रीय कानून मंत्री एवं न्याय मंत्री ने यह भी स्पष्ट किया है कि भारतीय विधि आयोग की रिपोर्ट में भारत सरकार की कोई भूमिका/हस्तक्षेप नहीं है।

उक्त आश्वासन के बाद, बार कौंसिल ऑफ इण्डिया ने 2 मई, 2017 को प्रस्तावित विरोध मार्च सहित आगे के सभी विरोध कार्यक्रम को वापिस लेने का निर्णय लिया है।

बार कौंसिल ऑफ राजस्थान की विशेष समिति एवं तदर्थ समिति के सदस्यों ने राज्य में स्थित सभी बार संघों एवं समस्त अधिवक्ताओं द्वारा उक्त बिल के खिलाफ पूर्ण सहयोग/समर्थन करने के लिए उनको धन्यवाद ज्ञापित किया है एवं भविष्य में इसी प्रकार के सहयोग की आशा करती है।


